This 2.6 mile gentle and scenic walk takes in all the key points around the reservoir's edge. Walk through Bartley Meadows for beautiful views, over the playing field and walk through Bromwich Wood, our local nature reserve and ancient woodland. At the junction of Scotland Lane and Frankley Lane, cross onto the grass to take the off-road route to the back of the picturesque St Leonard's church, and/or turn left just before the junction to follow the perimeter fence towards the dam on Genners Lane where you will find the viewing platform.

The viewing point is a good place to start, but you can start at any point; it's a circular route. Some of the route is on grassland so sturdy footwear might be useful in wet weather.

As you enjoy the fantastic views and open countryside, stop along your way to hear our tales— scan the QR codes to take you to fantabulous videos, and learn more about our local history.

If the weather is wet or you simply fancy something to do instead of watching TV, you can listen to the tales from the comfort of your armchair with a cup of tea at your side.
